

AGREED ORDER

Parties

WHEREAS, the parties to the Agreed Order herein are the Kentucky Board of Chiropractic Examiners, hereinafter referred to as the "Board," and John J. Squicciarini, D.C., hereinafter referred to as the "Respondent";

Jurisdiction

WHEREAS, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to KRS Chapter 312 and the related administrative regulations;

History

WHEREAS, the Respondent advertised a free or discounted service on his website, <u>www.kentuckychiropractic.net</u>, without including adequate notice of the seventy-two (72) hour right of rescission required by KRS 312.019(9)(g) and 201 KAR 21:065, Section 2(1); and

WHEREAS, the Respondent had previously entered into an Agreed Order in August of 1995, for the same violation; and

WHEREAS, false and misleading information was published on this

same website regarding the Respondent's certifications and services offered in violation of 201 KAR 21:065 Section 1; and

WHEREAS, the parties mutually desire to settle the issues in an expeditious manner, without the need for a formal hearing.

Terms of Agreement

THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed between the undersigned parties that this matter shall be settled and resolved upon the following terms:

- 1) The Respondent shall carefully review the Agreed Order herein and enters into this Agreed Order knowingly, willingly and voluntarily and after having reviewed the due process rights afforded to the Respondent under KRS Chapter 312 and the accompanying regulations;
- 2) The Respondent, John J. Squicciarini, D.C., accepts the reprimand of the Board for the above-stated violations. The Respondent agrees to act more diligently in the future to insure that all advertising issued by the Respondent, or on the Respondent's behalf, complies with KRS Chapter 312 and the accompanying administrative regulations;
- 3) The Respondent shall notify all consumers known to him who responded to the advertisement and advise those consumers of the complete notice of right of rescission, as required by 201 KAR 21:065, Section 1(3) and Section 2(1). A copy of the notification to all consumers who responded to the advertisement shall be mailed to the Board *on or before August 29, 2014*;
- 4) The Respondent, John J. Squicciarini, D.C., shall pay a fine to the Board in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1000.00). Said fine shall be

made payable to the "Kentucky Board of Chiropractic Examiners."

- 5) The original, executed Agreed Order and fine must be received in the office of the Board, *postmarked no later than August 29, 2014*.
- 6) The Respondent must take and pass the National Board of
 Chiropractic Examiners Ethics and Boundaries Examination as given by the
 [12/13/2014]
 Ethics and Boundaries Assessment Services, LLC., within six (6) months of
 execution of this Agreed Order signified by the Board President's signature.
- 7) The Respondent acknowledges that he is ineligible for participation in any chiropractic preceptorship program for two (2) years pursuant to 201 KAR 21:085, Section 1(7); and
- 8) The Respondent, John J. Squicciarini, D.C., agrees that the failure to comply with any of the terms and conditions of this Agreed Order may result in the Board setting the matter for an administrative hearing in accord with KRS Chapter 13B.

Voluntary Waiver of Rights

The Respondent, John J. Squicciarini, D.C., has had the opportunity at all times to seek advice from competent counsel of choice. No coercion has been exerted upon the Respondent, nor have any promises been made other than those reflected in this Agreed Order.

Publication of Settlement Agreement

The Respondent acknowledges that, once adopted by the Board, this

Agreed Order may be considered a public document, available for inspection at
any time by any member of the public under the Kentucky Open Records Act,

and may be reportable under federal law. This Agreed Order may at any time be published on the Board's website, www.kbce.ky.gov.

Complete Agreement

This Agreed Order consists of four (4) pages and embodies the entire agreement between the Kentucky Board of Chiropractic Examiners and John J. Squicciarini, D.C.. It may not be altered, amended or modified without the express written consent of both parties.
