- Online Continuing Education Dr. Johnson made a motion to recommend the board promulgate a regulation, to delete 201 KAR 21:041 Section 3(3)(a)1. Motion seconded by Dr. England, carried.
- 201 KAR 21:042 Dr. England made a motion to defer consideration for further review. Motion seconded by Dr. Johnson, carried.
