IN RE: THE LICENSE TO PRACTICE CHIROPRACTIC HELD BY ROBERT R. MARINER, D.C.

## AGREED ORDER

Come the parties to this action, Robert R. Mariner,
D.C. and the Kentucky Board of Chiropractic Examiners, and hereby
state as follows:

- 1. That Robert R. Mariner, D.C. advertised to the public that Physical Therapy was offered as a service in his office, when, in fact, no licensed Physical Therapist was employed in his office; and that he did so in an advertisement or solicitation on August 29, 1991. A copy of said advertisement or solicitation is attached hereto. Robert R. Mariner, D.C. admits that by so advertising he violated KRS 327.020 (1) and (3), inasmuch as he is not licensed as a Physical Therapist pursuant to that statute; that by so advertising he violated KRS 312.150(1)(f), in that he was guilty of deception and misrepresentation; and that by so advertising he violated 201 KAR 21:065, in that said advertisement was misleading.
- 2. That the parties hereto agree to resolve the above-mentioned violations by having Robert R. Mariner, D.C., accept a total fine of \$1,000 pursuant to KRS 312.163(2), \$500 of which

fine is to be paid to the Board immediately upon the signing of this Agreed Order by Robert R. Mariner, D.C. This Agreed Order and said \$500 portion of said fine are to be submitted to the Board no later than December 18, 1991.

The remaining \$500 portion of said fine is hereby probated for a period of one year, with the conditions of such probation to be that Robert R. Mariner, D.C., shall not violate any portion of KRS 312 or the regulations promulgated pursuant thereto during said one-year period of probation.

- 3. That Robert R. Mariner, D.C. shall place in his office an 8 1/2 inch by 11 inch sign stating in bold letters that Robert R. Mariner, D.C., does not practice or offer Physical Therapy; and said sign shall be so placed that all who enter the office may see it.
- 4. That the failure of Robert R. Mariner, D.C., to perform any of the obligations which he has agreed to herein shall constitute grounds for revocation of his above-mentioned probation.
- 5. By entry of this Agreed Order, Robert R. Mariner, D.C. waives the right to a due process hearing as to the violations admitted to herein by him and he acknowledges that he has freely and voluntarily waived his right to counsel.

WHEREFORE, it is so agreed effective this 27th day of November, 1991.
