
## AGREED ORDER

Comes the Kentucky Board of Chiropractic Examiners, hereafter the "Board," and Troy D. Wood, D.C., hereafter the "Respondent," and the parties hereby agree as follows:

- 1. That the Peer Review Committee referred a case to the Board involving the Respondent on or about December 8, 2000. The Peer Review Committee noted multiple incidences of billing for services where there was insufficient/no documentation to support the services billed, in violation of 201 KAR 21:100;
- 2. That rather than pursue a hearing on these violations, the parties have decided to resolve this matter by means of this Agreed Order.

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- A. The Respondent shall be on probation for one (1) year from the date this Agreed Order is finally executed, as evidenced by the signature of the President, under the following conditions:
  - In addition to this current year's continuing education requirements, Respondent shall complete an *additional* 6 hours of approved continuing education in record keeping.
     Respondent shall tender proof of completing the additional hours of continuing



- education no later than December 31, 2001;
- 2. Respondent agrees that the Board's Field Coordinator shall make two (2) random, unannounced inspections of Respondent's office in the year following final execution of this Agreed Order. The Field Coordinator shall inspect Respondent's offices to ensure he is complying with the terms of this Agreed Order and all statutes and regulations with govern the practice of chiropractic.
- B. The Board agrees to terminate the period of probation upon proof that the Respondent has complied with (A)(1) of this Agreed Order, however, this will not affect the inspections by the Field Coordinator;
- C. The Respondent enters into this Agreed Order knowingly, willingly and voluntarily and after having reviewed the due process rights afforded to him under KRS Chapter 312 and the accompanying regulations;
- D. The Respondent understands that by signing this Agreed Order, he has waived his right to a hearing on the allegations, including the right to be present with counsel, to subpoena witnesses and to confront those against him, and the right to appeal the Board's decision as entered in the Agreed Order and the full panoply of rights of hearing and appeal as authorized by statute, regulation and court decision;
- E. This Agreed Order is subject to disclosure under the Kentucky Open Records Act;
- F. The Respondent acknowledges he is ineligible for participation in any chiropractic preceptorship program for five years pursuant to 201 KAR 21:085, Section 2(7);
- G. The Respondent agrees that his failure to comply with any of the terms of this Agreed Order may result in the Board setting this matter for hearing.
