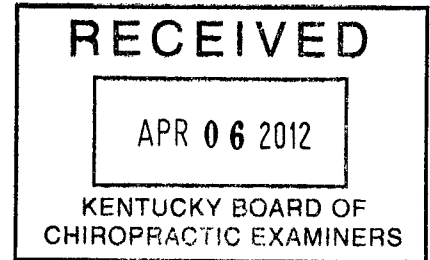

**AGREED ORDER**

***Parties***

**WHEREAS**, the parties to the Agreed Order herein are the Kentucky Board of Chiropractic Examiners, hereinafter referred to as the "Board," and Christopher E. Carter D.C., hereinafter referred to as the "Respondent."

***Jurisdiction***

**WHEREAS**, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to KRS Chapter 312 and the related administrative regulations.

***History***

**WHEREAS**, the Respondent advertised a free or discounted service on his digital sign and at the 2011 Kentucky State Fair, without including adequate notice of the seventy-two (72) hour right of rescission required by KRS 312.019(9)(g) and 201 KAR 21:065, Section 3(1); and

**WHEREAS**, the Respondent was found to have patient records which did not meet the minimum standards of recordkeeping as required by 201 KAR 21:100; and

**WHEREAS**, the Respondent advertised treatment of conditions outside of the scope of practice outlined by KRS 312.015 and KRS 312.017, and made claims regarding the Pro-Adjuster equipment which could not be substantiated in violation of KRS 312.150 (1)(d)(f)(g), 201 KAR 015 Section 1 (6) and 201 KAR 21:065 Section 2.

**WHEREAS**, the Respondent accepted payment for services not yet rendered to patients in violation of KRS 312.150(2)(c); and

**WHEREAS**, the parties mutually desire to settle the issue in an expeditious manner, without the need for a formal hearing.

#### ***Terms of Agreement***

**THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed** between the undersigned parties that this matter shall be settled and resolved upon the following terms:

1) The Respondent shall carefully review the Agreed Order herein and enters into this Agreed Order knowingly, willingly and voluntarily and after having reviewed the due process rights afforded to the respondent under KRS Chapter 312 and the accompanying regulations; and

2) The Respondent, Christopher E. Carter D.C., acknowledges that the Board has grounds to file allegations of violations of KRS 312.019(9)(g), 201 KAR 21:065, Section 3(1), 201 KAR 21:100, KRS 312.150 (1)(d)(f)(g), 201 KAR 015 Section 1 (6), 201 KAR 21:065 Section 2 and KRS 312.150 (2)(c). In the interest of settling this case in an expeditious manner, the Respondent admits violation and agrees to the following disciplinary terms set forth in the subsequent paragraphs:

3) The Respondent, Christopher E. Carter D.C., hereby agrees that, effective April 2, 2012, his license shall be revoked pursuant to this Agreed Order.

4) The Respondent shall, prior to making an application for licensure with this Board pursuant to KRS 312.085 or KRS 312.175, successfully complete (pass) the Ethics and Boundaries examination of the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners, with proof submitted to the Board; and

5) The original, executed Agreed Order must be received in the office of the Board, *postmarked no later than **April 6, 2012.***

#### ***Voluntary Waiver of Rights***

The Respondent, Christopher E. Carter D.C., has had the opportunity at all times to seek advice from competent counsel of choice. No coercion has been exerted upon the Respondent, nor have any promises been made other than those reflected in this Agreed Order.

#### ***Release of Liability***

In consideration of execution of this Agreed Order, the Respondent and the Respondent's executors, administrators, successors and assigns, hereby release and forever discharge the Commonwealth of Kentucky, the Kentucky Board of Chiropractic Examiners, and the Kentucky Attorney General and each of their members, agents, and employees in their individual and representative capacities, from any and all manner of actions, causes of action, suits, debts, judgments, executions, claims and demands whatsoever, known and unknown, in law or equity, that the Respondent ever had, now has, may have or claim to

have against any or all of the persons or entities named in this paragraph arising out of or by reason of this investigation, this disciplinary action, this Agreed Order, or its administration.


**Publication of Settlement Agreement**




**Complete Agreement**




