## **License Application Checklist**

The following documents/fees are needed to complete a new license application:

Ш	Completed Application for Licensure (found at kbce.ky.gov under Forms and Documents and Licensing
	Docs).
	\$350 Application Fee (must be a check or money order written out to Kentucky State Treasurer).
	Official copy of your NBCE Scores (Parts I-IV required in KY – must come directly to the board from
	NBCE).
	Official copy of your Chiropractic College Transcripts (must come directly to the board from the school).
	Official copy of your Undergraduate Transcripts (must come directly to the board from the school).
	A copy of your Chiropractic College Diploma (a picture of the diploma is fine).
	Completed Chiropractic College Certification forms (found in the Application for Licensure. Must
	complete and return both pages).
	Official license verifications for each state in which you have held or currently hold a license, if applicable.
	A copy of your license will not fulfill this requirement.
	3 Character Reference Letters.

Your <u>application and fee</u> must be submitted together by mail to PO Box 1360, Frankfort, KY 40602. All other documents can be mailed or emailed to <u>kbce@ky.gov</u>. Per our retention schedule, we will keep the documents for all incomplete applications one year before destroying them. Complete applications are reviewed by the board on a weekly basis and there is typically a two week turnaround from the date it is sent for review.
