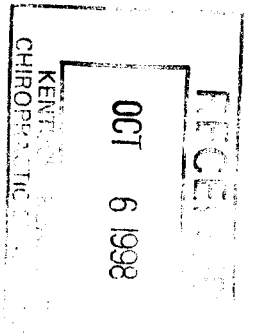

AGREED ORDER

Comes the Kentucky Board of Chiropractic Examiners, hereafter the "Board," and Brenda Brown, D.C., hereafter the "Respondent," and the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. That the Board received information from the National Practitioner Data Bank relevant to a malpractice claim against the Respondent on or about May 2, 1997;
2. That rather than pursue a hearing on the allegation, the parties have decided to resolve this matter by means of this Agreed Order.


WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- a. Respondent's license to practice chiropractic in Kentucky shall be suspended from December 1, 1998, through November 30, 2000;
- b. Respondent may not perform chiropractic services or hold herself out as a chiropractor during her suspension;
- c. Respondent's license will be reinstated on December 1, 2000, provided she has complied with all the terms of this Agreed Order and committed no further violations of law;


- d. Respondent shall tender proof of completing an approved twelve (12) hour risk management continuing education course during her suspension. This course will be in addition to any yearly continuing education requirements Respondent must complete;
- e. Respondent shall tender proof of completing an approved twelve (12) hour recordkeeping continuing education course during her suspension. This course will be in addition to any yearly continuing education requirements Respondent must complete;
- f. Respondent shall tender proof of successful completion of the SPEC (Special Purposes Examination for Chiropractic) exam before her license to practice chiropractic in Kentucky will be reinstated;
- g. Respondent shall continue to pay renewal fees and complete her yearly continuing education requirements during her suspension;
- h. Respondent enters into this Agreed Order knowingly, willingly and voluntarily, upon advice of counsel, and after having reviewed the due process rights afforded to her under KRS Chapter 312 and the accompanying regulations;
- i. Respondent understands that by signing this Agreed Order, she has waived her right to a hearing on the allegations, including the right to be present with counsel, to subpoena witnesses and to confront those against her, and the right to appeal the Board's decision as entered in the Agreed Order and the

full panoply of rights of hearing and appeal as authorized by statute, regulation and court decision;

- j. This Agreed Order is subject to disclosure under the Kentucky Open Records Act;
- k. Respondent acknowledges she is ineligible for participation in any chiropractic preceptorship program during her suspension and for five years thereafter, pursuant to 201 KAR 21:085, Section 2(7);
- l. Respondent agrees that her failure to comply with any of the terms of this Agreed Order may result in the Board setting this matter for hearing.
