Frequently Asked Questions

The Kentucky Board of Chiropractic Examiners (the Board) provides the following frequently asked questions and answers to guide chiropractors licensed in Kentucky.

1. May I offer a prepayment option to a patient for a course of treatment?

- a. No. It is unprofessional conduct to charge a patient for services not rendered and may be grounds for disciplinary action. KRS 312.150(2)(c); KRS 312.150(1)(f).

2. May I offer patients a contract for a course of treatment?

- a. No. It is unprofessional conduct to have a patient enter into a contract for a course of treatment and may be grounds for disciplinary action. KRS 312.150(2)(d); KRS 312.150(1)(f).

3. May I offer a "VIP" or an "all-inclusive pass" to patients for unlimited treatments?

- a. No. It is unprofessional conduct to perform unnecessary services, to enter into a contract for a course of treatment, or to charge a patient for services not rendered, and may be grounds for disciplinary action. KRS 312.150(2)(b), (c), (d); KRS 312.150(1)(f).

4. I have a question about my insurance coverage for my chiropractic business. Can the Board answer my question?

- a. The Board does not give legal advice to licensees. If you need legal advice, you should seek legal counsel. You may wish to contact a chiropractic trade association that may be able to assist you.
