CALL TO ORDER

Dr. England called the meeting to order at 12:03 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Dr. England made a motion to accept the April 28, 2022 minutes as presented. Motion seconded by Dr. Johnson, carried.

REGULATIONS COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

- Manipulation of Animals – ongoing
- IANM Specialty – Dr. England made a motion to recommend the Board approve the IANM specialty. Motion seconded by Dr. Johnson, carried.
- Clinical Electrodiagnosis Specialty – Dr. Johnson made a motion to authorize administrative staff to draft a letter to chiropractic colleges, with review by counsel and approval by the committee chair, regarding whether electrodiagnosis is taught as part of their college curriculum. Motion seconded by Dr. England, carried.
- Dr. Johnson made motion to send a letter drafted by administrative staff, with review by counsel and approval from the committee chair, to request information from requestor for how proposed specialty meets regulation requirements. Motion seconded by Dr. England, carried.
- Telehealth – HB 188 – Dr. England made a motion to recommend that a telehealth regulation be drafted by board counsel to start the regulation promulgation process to indicate that chiropractic is medically necessary in person except consultations limited to one per month per patient. Motion seconded by Dr. Johnson, carried.
- Online Continuing Education – Dr. Johnson made a motion to recommend the board promulgate a regulation, to delete 201 KAR 21:041 Section 3(3)(a)1. Motion seconded by Dr. England, carried.
- 201 KAR 21:042 – Dr. England made a motion to defer consideration for further review. Motion seconded by Dr. Johnson, carried.
- Continuing Education Forms – Defer consideration.

A motion was made by Dr. Johnson to adjourn the meeting at 12:57 p.m. Motion seconded by Dr. England, carried.
