AGREED ORDER

Parties

WHEREAS, the parties to the Agreed Order hereinafter are the Kentucky Board of Chiropractic Examiners, herein referred to as the "BOARD", and MICHAEL YOUNG, hereinafter referred to as "Respondent";

Jurisdiction

WHEREAS, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to KRS Chapter 312 and the related administrative regulations;

History

WHEREAS, the Respondent was found to be in violation of KRS 312.150(1)(g) and KRS 312.150(2) and,

WHEREAS, the parties mutually desire to settle the issues in an expeditious manner, without the need for a formal hearing.

WHEREAS, the Respondent desires to enter into an Agreed Order hereby; and

WHEREFORE, it is hereby agreed between the undersigned parties that this matter shall be settled and resolved upon the following terms:

- The Respondent shall carefully review the Agreed Order herein and enters into this Agreed Order knowingly, willingly and voluntarily and after having reviewed the due process rights afforded to the Respondent under KRS Chapter 312 and the accompanying regulations;
- 2) The Respondent, Michael Young, D.C., accepts the condition of probation on his license imposed by the Board for the above-stated violations. His probation will run until he renews his license in 2024. The Respondent agrees to act more diligently in the future to insure he complies with KRS Chapter 312 and the accompanying administrative regulations;
- 3) The original, executed Agreed Order must be received in the office of the Board, postmarked no later than 14 days from the date the Respondent signs this Agreed Order.
- 4) The Respondent, Michael Young, D.C., agrees that the failure to comply with any of the terms and conditions of this Agreed Order may result in the revocation of his probation and the Board will, in such event, set this matter for an administrative hearing to take disciplinary action against his license in accord with KRS Chapter 13B.

Voluntary Waiver of Rights

The Respondent, Michael Young, D.C., has had the opportunity at all times to seek ad vice from competent counsel of choice. No coercion has been exerted upon the Respondent, nor have any promises been made other than those reflected in this Agreed Order.

Publication of Settlement Agreement

The Respondent acknowledges that, once adopted by the Board, this Agreed Order may be considered a public document, available for inspection at any time by any member of the public under the Kentucky Open Records Act, and may be reportable under federal law. This Agreed Order may at any time be published on the Board's website, https://kbce.ky.gov.

Complete Agreement

This Agreed Order consists of two (2) pages and embodies the entire agreement between the Kentucky Board of Chiropractic Examiners and Michael Young, D.C. It may not be altered, amended or modified without the express consent of both parties.
