Dr. England called the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Dr. England made a motion to accept the March 3, 2022 minutes as presented. Motion seconded by Dr. Johnson, carried.

REGULATIONS COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

Dr. Johnson made a motion to set the regular 2022 schedule of the regulations committee as follows: July 14, 2022, September 16, 2022, and November 18, 2022. All meetings will begin at noon EST. Motion seconded by Dr. England, carried.

The committee discussed HB 188 and how that may impact telehealth law KRS 312.220. Dr. England made a motion for the committee to draft telehealth recommendations, bring those to the board for further discussion, and to begin the regulation process. Motion seconded by Dr. Johnson, carried.

The committee discussed the manipulation of animals. The committee recommended Counsel to discuss a possible animal manipulation bill with KBVE. In said bill, the committee proposed to add a category of licensure that does not require complete veterinary training, but does require a more robust animal manipulation training.
