- 4 201 KAR 21:095. Licensure, registration, and standards of persons performing peer review.
- 5 RELATES TO: KRS 312.175, 312.200(3)
- 6 STATUTORY AUTHORITY: KRS 312.019(9)
- 7 NECESSITY, FUNCTION, AND CONFORMITY: KRS 312.019(9) authorizes the board to
- 8 promulgate administrative regulations consistent with KRS Chapter 312 governing the practice
- 9 of chiropractic. KRS 312.200(3) requires that persons performing peer review of chiropractic
- 10 claims be licensed by the board, complete annually a board approved utilization review course,
- and annually register with the board and pay a registration fee. This administrative regulation es-
- tablishes the requirements for the licensure, review course, registration, and registration fee for
- persons to perform peer review services.
- Section 1. Requirements for Licensure and Registration. A person performing chiropractic
- 15 peer review shall:
- 16 (1) Hold a current active license to practice chiropractic within the Commonwealth of Ken-
- 17 tucky;
- 18 (2)
- 19 (a) For the first year that a person seeks to register to perform peer review, have previously
- successfully completed a course consisting of a minimum of 100 hours of utilization review and
- 21 independent medical examination from a chiropractic college or university accredited by the

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- 1 Council on Chiropractic Education; and
- 2 (b) For each year thereafter that a person seeks to register to perform peer review, have com-
- 3 pleted six (6) hours of continuing education in topics specifically related to utilization review and
- 4 approved by the board to meet this requirement; and [which-shall-be obtained-at-a live, in-person
- 5 event within the Commonwealth of Kentucky; and]
- 6 (3) Register annually with the board, by June 1 of each year, by:
- 7 (a) Presenting evidence of satisfactory compliance with the requirements established in this
- 8 section and of having met the education requirements of KRS 312.175;
- 9 (b) Completing the Registration Form for Persons Performing Peer Review of Kentucky Chi-
- 10 ropractic Claims; and
- 11 (c) Paying a registration fee of fifty (50) dollars.
- Section 2. In performing peer review activities, a licensee shall:
- 13 (1) Render the actual review service and documented report;
- 14 (2) Personally retain a copy of all records associated with each peer review case for a mini-
- mum of seven (7) years;
- 16 (3) Employ minimum standards associated with the practice of chiropractic and comply with
- the code of ethical conduct established in 201 KAR 21:015;
- 18 (4) Provide a report that includes the rationale for the determination in order that the licensee
- 19 provider is given adequate information to appeal;
- 20 (5) Sign all reports, unless the review is performed under the Kentucky Chiropractic Board of
- 21 Examiners Peer Review Committee, in which case, the board's administrator or designee shall
- 22 sign the determination;
- 23 (6) Review in accordance with accepted standards as defined in 201 KAR 21:001;

- 1 (7) Review thoroughly and rely on all documents provided to the reviewer;
- 2 (8) List in the resulting report all documents provided to the reviewer and list all documents
- 3 reviewed; and
- 4 (9) Personally conduct the review and prepare the report.
- 5 Section 3. Complaint Procedure Related to Peer Reviewers. A complaint against a peer re-
- 6 viewer alleging a violation of this administrative regulation or any other provision of KRS Chap-
- 7 ter 312 or 201 KAR Chapter 21 shall be filed and processed according to the procedure estab-
- 8 lished in 201 KAR 21:051.
- 9 Section 4. Incorporation by Reference.
