

**AGREED ORDER**

***Parties***

**WHEREAS**, the parties to the Agreed Order herein are the Kentucky Board of Chiropractic Examiners, hereinafter referred to as the "Board," and Michael T. Thompson, D.C., hereinafter referred to as the "Respondent."

***Jurisdiction***

**WHEREAS**, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to KRS Chapter 312 and the related administrative regulations.

***History***

*M* **WHEREAS**, the Kentucky Board of Chiropractic Examiners having received an application for renewal from Michael T. Thompson, D.C.; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board received a letter from attorney Michael J. Hollenbeck, dated August 12, 2004, advising the Board that the case in Switzerland Superior Court, Switzerland County, Indiana, No. 78-D01-9912-

DF-415, was dismissed with prejudice; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties mutually desire to settle the issues in an expeditious manner, without the need for a formal hearing.

***Terms of Agreement***

**THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed** between the undersigned parties that this matter shall be settled and resolved upon the following terms:

- 1) The Respondent shall carefully review the Agreed Order herein and if he accepts the terms and conditions attached to the issuance of his license as set forth in paragraphs 3, 4, 5 and 6 below, shall sign and date the Agreed Order and return the original on or before October 14, 2004;
- 2) The Board shall issue a license to practice chiropractic in the Commonwealth of Kentucky to Michael T. Thompson immediately upon receipt of the aforementioned executed Agreed Order;
- 3) The Respondent's license to practice chiropractic shall be placed on *PROBATION* for a period of one (1) year, effective the date of issuance of the license;
- 4) During said probationary period, the Respondent agrees to abide by the rules and regulations governing the practice of chiropractic in the Commonwealth of Kentucky as set forth in KRS Chapter 312 and the applicable administrative regulations;
- 5) Furthermore, during said probationary period, if the Respondent is

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charged with a felony drug or weapons-related violation of any of the laws or regulations of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, his license shall be immediately suspended, pending adjudication of the charge(s) in a court of competent jurisdiction and an administrative hearing conducted in accordance with KRS Chapter 13B; and

- 6) Furthermore, during said probationary period, the Respondent agrees to attend substance abuse counseling sessions and to submit to two (2) drug screenings, one in December and one in May. Substance abuse counselor reports shall be submitted on a quarterly basis (January, April, July and October) to:

Drug screening results shall also be sent to Ms. White at the above-mentioned address. Failure to submit the substance abuse counselor reports or the drug screening results, shall be considered a violation of the Agreed Order herein and shall result in the *immediate suspension* of the Respondent's license pending adjudication in an administrative hearing conducted in accordance with KRS Chapter 13B.

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### ***Voluntary Waiver of Rights***

The Respondent, Michael T. Thompson, has had the opportunity at all times to seek advice from competent counsel of choice. No coercion has been exerted upon the Respondent, nor have any promises been made other than those reflected in this Agreed Order.

The Respondent is fully aware of his rights to contest the Board's denial of his application for renewal in a formal hearing. These rights include: representation by an attorney at the Respondent's own expense, the right to confront and cross-examine witnesses called to testify against the Respondent, the right to present evidence on the Respondent's own behalf, the right to testify on his own behalf, the right to receive written findings of fact and conclusions of law supporting the decision on the merits of the accusation and the right to obtain judicial review of the Board's decision. All of these rights are being voluntarily waived by the Respondent in exchange for the Board's acceptance of this Agreed Order.

### ***Publication of Settlement Agreement***

The Respondent acknowledges that, once adopted by the Board, this Agreed Order may be considered a public document, available for inspection at any time by any member of the public under the Kentucky Open Records Act, and may be reportable under federal law.

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
**Complete Agreement**
