**AGREED ORDER**

***Parties***

**WHEREAS**, the parties to the Agreed Order herein are the Kentucky Board of Chiropractic Examiners, hereinafter referred to as the "Board," and Peter Jeffrey Fagerland D.C., hereinafter referred to as the "Respondent."

***Jurisdiction***

**WHEREAS**, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to KRS Chapter 312 and the related administrative regulations.

***History***

**WHEREAS**, the Respondent performed a chiropractic peer review on March 27, 2013 for Exam Works, Inc. on claim number 10-01-00022201 in violation of KRS 312.200 (3); and

**WHEREAS**, the parties mutually desire to settle the issue in an expeditious manner, without the need for a formal hearing.

***Terms of Agreement***

**THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed** between the undersigned parties that

this matter shall be settled and resolved upon the following terms:

1) The Respondent shall carefully review the Agreed Order herein and enters into this Agreed Order knowingly, willingly and voluntarily and after having reviewed the due process rights afforded to the respondent under KRS Chapter 312 and the accompanying regulations;

2) The Respondent, Peter Jeffrey Fagerland, D.C., accepts the reprimand of the Board for the above-stated violation. The Respondent agrees to act more diligently in the future to insure that he complies with KRS Chapter 312 and 201 KAR Chapter 21;

3) The Respondent, Peter Jeffrey Fagerland, D.C., shall pay a fine to the board in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00). Said fine shall be made payable to the "Kentucky Board of Chiropractic Examiners."

4) The original, executed Agreed Order and fine must be received in the office of the board, *postmarked no later than December 18, 2013.*

5) The Respondent shall cease and desist from performing chiropractic peer reviews until which time he has complied with KRS 312.200 (3).

6) The Respondent acknowledges that he is ineligible for participation in any chiropractic preceptorship program for two (2) years pursuant to 201 KAR 21:085, Section 2(7); and

7) The Respondent, Peter Jeffrey Fagerland, D.C., agrees that the failure to comply with any of the terms and conditions of this Agreed Order may result in the board setting the matter for an administrative hearing in

accord with KRS Chapter 13B.

**Voluntary Waiver of Rights**

The Respondent, Peter Jeffrey Fagerland, D.C., has had the opportunity at all times to seek advice from competent counsel of choice. No coercion has been exerted upon the Respondent, nor have any promises been made other than those reflected in this Agreed Order.


**Publication of Settlement Agreement**

**Complete Agreement**


